TRI-CITY QUILTER'S GUILD MEMBERSHIP LOGO – NAME TAG

Choose your size: Small = 3" Large = $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

- 1. Cut 5 of pattern A. Use a variety of fabric colors or prints. Use ½" seams throughout. Sew together along the long sides into a fan shape. Press all seams in one direction.
- 2. Cut 1 piece from pattern B. Use a coordinating fabric.
- 3. Applique unit B in place on the fan shape.
- 4. Place the fan into the lower left corner of a square piece (3½" small or 4½" large) of white or muslin background fabric and applique across the top curved edge. This will be referred to as the fan square.
- 5. For name block, cut a rectangle 3½" x 2½" (small) or 4" x 3" (large) from background fabric. Sew to the bottom edge of the fan square.
- 6. Embroider, stencil, or mark with a pen (NOT a Sharpie), your first and last names onto the name block. First name can be larger than last. Name should be readable from several feet away.
- 7. Cut 1 piece of thin batting the full size of the name tag. Baste it to the back side of the name tag.
- 8. Cut 1 piece of backing the size of the name tag. Pin together the name tag and the backing with right sides together.
- 9. Stitch around name tag. Use 1/4" seam allowance. Leave an opening of 1 to 2 inches for turning right side out. Turn right side out and slipstitch the opening closed.
- 10. Quilt your name tag. Suggested: in-the-ditch or □" from seams. Optional: add ribbons, lace, embroidery, etc. Also, you may place pins onto your name tag such as membership pin, show pins, etc.
